

ONLINE MASTER OF SCIENCE IN GAME DEVELOPMENT

To apply to the online Master of Science in Game Development program at DigiPen Institute of Technology, you must submit the following materials:

- Completed online application form**
- Resume**
- Statement of purpose (optional)**
A written statement describing your interest in pursuing graduate study in game development, your professional goals, and how the program aligns with your background and aspirations.
- Academic transcripts**
Official transcript(s) from each college or university attended. Unofficial transcripts may be used for admissions decision-making.
- Standardized tests (optional)**
GRE scores are not required for admission.

Application Process at DigiPen

You will submit your application materials through the online application portal.

Materials typically uploaded through the application portal include:

- Application form
- Resume
- Optional statement of purpose
- Unofficial transcripts

Applicants will also need to arrange for official transcripts from each institution attended to be sent directly to DigiPen Institute of Technology.

FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Applicants who completed their academic training outside the U.S. may be required to submit credential evaluations and English language proficiency documentation.

DigiPen accepts the following forms of verification:

Standardized Test Scores

- **TOEFL iBT:** Minimum score of 80
- **TOEFL Paper-Based Test:** Minimum score of 550
 - **DigiPen institution code: 4138**
- **IELTS:** Minimum score of 6.5
 - No individual subscore lower than 6.0
- **Duolingo English Test:** Minimum score of 115
- **Cambridge English:** Advanced (CAE): Minimum score of C1
